- -- Rehearsals will be held at the St. Charles Borromeo Convocation Hall (101 Airport Rd, Romeville) on the campus of Lewis University, which is #1 on the map link. To get to this building, please do not use the main entrance of Lewis. Instead, go one stoplight further north on Route 53 to Airport Road. Turn west onto Airport Road. - -- Rehearsal times are 6:15-8:45pm on Wednesdays.
- --Seating placement will be posted at the door when you arrive.
- -- Please bring your own water with you. Some snacks will be available during break for a pay-what-you-wish donation, with proceeds going towards the end-of-year pizza party.

Attendance

- A. Attendance is mandatory for rehearsals, concerts, and sectionals.

 Rehearsals are held at the Borromeo Convocation Hall at Lewis University on Wednesday from 6:15 PM until 8:45 PM.
- B. Three absences during a season can be reason for dismissal from the orchestra. (adopted by MYSO board 5-23-11)
- C. Musicians are expected to be prompt. All members should allow enough time to warm-up, tune, and be ready to play at the scheduled rehearsal time. Bring all necessary equipment and accessories pencil, mutes, reeds, and extra strings.
- D. All musicians are important to the orchestra. When a musician is accepted by audition into the orchestra s/he makes a commitment to attend all rehearsals and all performances. If a musician has a conflict with a performance s/he must notify the music director and the executive director before the first rehearsal of the concert cycle.

2024 STUDENT COMPOSITION CONTEST

The Student Composition Competition is being held for the 2023-2024 season and will be held every other year. Student composers enrolled in high school, an undergraduate degree program, or a graduate degree program are eligible. Deadline is November 15, 2023.

Submission Guidelines and Information:

- Composers must be enrolled in high school, an undergraduate degree program, or graduate degree program during the 2023-24 academic year.
- Composers may submit one work only
- Works that have been previously performed are eligible
- Only works written after 2016 are eligible
- Work may not exceed 15 minutes
- Composition should be scored for a youth orchestra (3-3-3-2, 4-3-2-1, piano, strings)
- Works that use electronics will also be considered
- Concertos or works with extended solos are not eligible.
- The difficulty level should not exceed that of Beethoven's Symphony #1 or Sibelius' Finlandia.
